




HOLD LUGGAGE



Each item you check-in as hold luggage has to be under a standard weight of 20kg per bag. Except for sporting and medical equipment.

- > Hold luggage has to be under a certain size and weight. Its total size has to be under 275cm (to find this out simply add its length + width + height) and a standard weight of 20kg per bag, except for sporting and medical equipment.
- > The standard hold luggage allowance is three items per passenger. There is a charge for each item.
- > If you're travelling with infants or children, they have the same luggage allowance as adults: three items of hold luggage per person. For example, if you are a couple with one infant (in other words three passengers), the group can add up to nine hold bags online.
- > You can pool your total luggage weight allowance – across items and across customers – but an individual item cannot weigh more than 32 kg.
- > You can add luggage to a Standard Fare via your GDS or booking tool in the booking flow.
- > Should you wish to add baggage at the airport the cost will be significantly higher.
- > The minimum weight you can buy is 20kg per hold item. If you'd like to bring a heavier hold item you can buy additional weight in increments of 3kg up to the maximum weight of 32kg.
- > If you pay for excess weight at the airport, it will be more expensive.
