

PRE-TRAVEL CHECKLIST

You'll need to make sure that you and everyone in your party completes the following steps, to make sure you meet the entry requirements for your holiday.



STEP ONE

Make sure you have comprehensive travel insurance for your holiday, and it's best to have this in place from the moment you book. You should also check carefully that the level of cover meets your needs.



STEP TWO

Ensuring your passport has enough time remaining before it expires. Your passport needs to be in good condition and signed, and often valid for a minimum period beyond your trip, usually at least three or six months. It may also be required to be less than 10 years old.



STEP THREE

Checking the rules about vaccinations ahead of travelling to see if they form part of any entry requirements and whether all vaccines are accepted and how many doses you'll need to have had.



STEP FOUR

Checking whether you'll need to get tested for Covid-19, and if so, when and where to take it, as well as the type of test you may need to do. This could be an important part of travelling for your holiday. Find out more [here](#).

Complete and submit documentation, such as Passenger Locator Forms, in advance of travel and have these documents to hand to show at the airport before your flights.
